

COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given, in accordance with the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), that the following by-laws were adopted by the urban agglomeration council at its meeting of May 16, 2024:

RCG 24-023 Règlement autorisant la construction et l'occupation d'un bâtiment à des fins résidentielles pour personnes ayant besoin d'aide et d'hébergement sur le lot 6 377 181

The by-law authorizes the construction and occupancy of a building for housing purposes for persons in need of assistance and lodging on lot 6 377 181.

RCG 24-026 Règlement autorisant la démolition, la construction et l'occupation d'un bâtiment situé sur les lots 1 573 180, 1 573 181, 1 573 179 et 1 573 606 du cadastre du Québec à des fins d'hébergement dans le cadre d'un programme de logement social

The by-law authorizes the demolition, construction and occupancy of a building located on lots 1 573 180, 1 573 181, 1 573 179 and 1 573 606, cadastre of Québec, for housing purposes, under a social housing program.

Following the public notice published on May 22, 2024, in this newspaper, and in accordance with sections 137.13, 137.15 and 264.0.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), these by-laws are deemed to be in conformity with the Montréal urban agglomeration land use and development plan as of June 22, 2024, and comes into force on that date.
