

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS URBAN PLANNING ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The Borough Council invites borough residents interested in taking part in the work of the Urban Planning Advisory Committee (CCU) to apply for a position on the Committee, by submitting their name, contact information and reasons for applying.

Positions to be filled

One regular member, age 35 or younger Two substitute members Applications received may also be used to fill any other future vacancies.

Roles of the CCU

The Committee's roles are to review and make recommendations to the Borough Council on any application relating to urban planning and development. The Committee also reviews and decides, during public hearings, on building demolition permit applications. The Committee has seven regular and up to seven substitute members, with renewable two-year terms. It generally meets monthly. Members of the Urban Planning Advisory Committee who are not members of the Borough Council are entitled to remuneration of \$75 for each meeting they attend.

Qualifications

Candidates for this position must:

- live in the Côte-des-Neiges-Notre-Dame-de-Grâce borough;
- have knowledge of urban planning, development, architecture or heritage <u>or</u> have been actively involved in the Montréal economic, cultural, scientific, community or educational sector;
- have a good knowledge of French;
- be available in the evening, for monthly meetings;
- have access to a computer and have an email address, since all documents will be distributed in this way.

Candidates from socio-demographic groups underrepresented on the CCU are particularly welcome.

Aptitudes

Candidates must have the following aptitudes:

- ethical sense and integrity;
- good judgment;
- critical sense and analytical skills;
- ability to work on a team;
- ability to communicate and share opinions.
