

## COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

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Notice is given, in accordance with the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), that the following by-law was adopted by city council at its meeting of October 21, 2024:

**04-047-272 Règlement modifiant le Plan d'urbanisme de la Ville de Montréal (04-047)**

This by-law to amend the city's planning program replaces the "convent, monastery and place of worship" land use designation with "residential" for the sites of the former Saint-Enfant-Jésus parish complex and the Maison du citoyen in Rivière-des-Prairies-Pointe-aux-Trembles borough, and creates a new list of historic buildings, "historic places of worship," to add the aforementioned sites. The "parks and green spaces" map is also amended.

Following the public notice published on October 29, 2024, in this newspaper, and in accordance with sections 137.13, 137.15 and 264.0.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (CQLR, c. A-19.1), this by-law is deemed to be in conformity with the Montréal urban agglomeration land use and development plan as of November 29, 2024, and comes into force on that date.
