

COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the city council meeting of June 16, 2025:

25-012 **Règlement autorisant la transformation et l'occupation des parties de bâtiment situées au 5450, rue Fullum, aux fins de l'exercice de l'usage « lieu de retour » en vue de permettre l'établissement et le maintien des installations requises pour assurer le retour des contenants consignés**

The by-law authorizes the conversion and occupancy of parts of building located at 5450, rue Fullum, for the purposes of establishing and maintaining facilities for the return of returnable containers.

02-136-12 **Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur le Conseil du patrimoine de Montréal (02-136)**

The by-law amends by-law 02-136 concerning the Conseil du patrimoine de Montréal, the city's heritage council. The amendments add mandatory opinions for certain demolition projects as well as new administrative rules governing heritage council members.

20-041-15 **Règlement modifiant le Règlement visant à améliorer l'offre en matière de logement social, abordable et familial (20-041)**

The by-law amends schedule B of by-law 20-041 concerning the improvement of the supply of social, affordable and family housing by adding affordable housing zones in Rosemont–La Petite-Patrie and Mercier–Hochelaga-Maisonneuve boroughs.

24-017 **Règlement révisant le Plan d'urbanisme de la Ville de Montréal et son document complémentaire et le remplaçant par le Plan d'urbanisme et de mobilité 2050**

The by-law revises the city's planning program and complementary document by replacing them with the "Plan d'urbanisme et de mobilité 2050" (PUM). The complete version and summary of the new planning program (PUM) are available for consultation (in French) on the city's website at montreal.ca.
