## PUBLIC NOTICE

---

Notice is given that the draft by-law entitled By-law concerning the remuneration of members of the urban agglomeration council and members of its standing committees was tabled at the urban agglomeration council meeting of November 2, 2006 and that a notice of motion was filed for its adoption at a subsequent council meeting.

The draft by-law provides that all members of the urban agglomeration council will receive a basic annual remuneration of 10 000 \$.

It also provides for additional remuneration for special positions within the standing committees of the urban agglomeration council:

- Chairman of a standing committee, including the Commission de la sécurité publique: 750 \$ / meeting, to a maximum of 15 000 \$ per year;
- Vice-chairman of a standing committee, including the Commission de la sécurité publique: 500 \$ / meeting, to a maximum of 10 000 \$ per year;
- Member of a standing committee, including the Commission de la sécurité publique: 250 \$ / meeting, to a maximum of 5 000 \$ per year.

The draft by-law provides that the remunerations will be retroactive to January 1, 2006.

It also provides that the remunerations will be adjusted annually following the year it comes into force, except for 2007. The indexation will therefore apply as of fiscal 2008.

As a result of the adoption of this by-law, the amount of the expense allowance paid to certain council members will be increased as follows:
