Notice is given that a **special city council meeting** will be held as follows:

The special meeting of **January 12, 2026**, will pertain to the tabling of the 2026-2035 ten-year capital works program (central city component), the tabling of the 2026 budget (central city) and the tabling of the 2026 budget of certain paramunicipal agencies.

Anyone who wishes to ask questions in person must be present one hour prior to the meeting on **the ground floor of city hall, located at 275 rue Notre-Dame Est** to obtain a registration number. The draw determining the order in which people may ask their questions will take place 30 minutes prior to the meeting. It is imperative that citizens provide a picture ID for registration purposes.

Members of the public can also ask elected officials questions by submitting their questions electronically **before 10 a.m., on Monday, January 12, 2026**, using the online form, according to the instructions posted on the city's website at **montreal.ca**, on the page of the January 12, 2026 special city council meeting. Full details on the procedure for public questions (in person and via the online form) are provided on the website.

People registered for the in-person question period as well as people who wish to attend council deliberations may access city hall using the door on the west side (place Vauquelin) or east side (rue Gosford).

A Québec sign language (QSL) or American Sign Language (ASL) interpretation service is available on request, subject to the availability of interpreters. If you require this service, please call 514-872-3142. The service is subject to the availability of interpreters.
