

## COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

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### Notice is given that city council:

- adopted the following by-law at its regular meeting of January 26, 2026:

**26-002      Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur la subvention à la modification du raccordement du service électrique de certains bâtiments (S-6.01)**

The by-law amends the by-law concerning subsidies for the alteration of the electrical service connection of certain buildings (R.B.C.M., c. S-6.01) by replacing schedule Q to increase certain subsidy amounts.

- adopted the following by-laws at its special meeting of January 28, 2026:

**26-004      Règlement sur les taxes (exercice financier 2026)**

This by-law concerns taxes for fiscal 2026.

**26-005      Règlement concernant la taxe foncière sur les parcs de stationnement (exercice financier 2026)**

This by-law concerns property tax on parking lots for fiscal 2026.

**26-006      Règlement sur les tarifs (exercice financier 2026)**

This by-law concerns fees for fiscal 2026.

**26-007      Règlement relatif à la tarification de l'eau fournie aux immeubles non résidentiels (exercice financier 2026)**

This by-law concerns tariffing of water supplied to non-residential buildings for fiscal 2026.

**18-020-5    Règlement modifiant le Règlement fixant le montant des amendes à l'égard des infractions en matière de stationnement ou d'immobilisation des véhicules (18-020)**

The by-law amends by-law 18-020 concerning vehicle parking or immobilization fines by increasing the fines.
