

## COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

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Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the city council meeting of March 23, 2026:

- 26-011**      **Règlement établissant le programme d'aide aux entreprises qualifiées d'établissement de vitalité nocturne**  
The by-law establishes the assistance program for qualified nightlife establishments.
- 18-038-4**    **Règlement modifiant le Règlement du conseil de la ville sur la gestion contractuelle (18-038)**  
The by-law amends city council's by-law 18-038 concerning contract management to comply with new provisions of the Act respecting contracting by municipal bodies (CQLR, c. C-65.01), in particular by introducing measures to promote responsible procurement.
- 26-012**      **Règlement sur les services**  
This by-law takes effect on April 20, 2026, and replaces, as of that date, by-law 22-017 concerning city departments.
- 20-041-16**   **Règlement modifiant le Règlement visant à améliorer l'offre en matière de logement social, abordable et familial (20-041)**  
This by-law amends by-law 20-041 concerning the improvement of the supply of social, affordable and family housing. Amendments limit the by-law's scope to projects over 18,000 m<sup>2</sup> and decrease required financial contributions. Affordable housing requirements are modified and schedules B and D are repealed.
