

COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of March 26, 2026:

RCG 25-015-1 Règlement modifiant le règlement numéro RCG 25-015 modifiant le Règlement sur la subvention à la réalisation de logements coopératifs et à but non lucratif (AccèsLogis Montréal) (02-102)

This by-law amends transitional measures in by-law RCG 25-015 amending by-law 02-102 concerning subsidies for the development of non-profit cooperative housing (AccèsLogis Montréal) to allow for early repayment of a loan taken out for the initial contribution to a contingency fund.

RCG 18-024-4 Règlement modifiant le Règlement du conseil d'agglomération sur la gestion contractuelle (RCG 18-024)

The by-law amends by-law RCG 18-024 concerning contract management to comply with new provisions of the Act respecting contracting by municipal bodies (CQLR, c. C-65.01), in particular by introducing measures to promote responsible procurement.

RCG 24-036-1 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur la subvention relative à la réduction des nuisances liées au bruit généré par les salles de spectacle indépendantes de moins de 3 000 places (RCG 24-036)

The by-law amends by-law RCG 24-036 establishing a subsidy program for the reduction of noise generated by independent performance halls with fewer than 3,000 seats by relaxing eligibility criteria.
