



## OPENING OF A REGISTER

### TO QUALIFIED VOTERS ENTITLED TO HAVE THEIR NAMES ENTERED ON THE REFERENDUM LIST FOR THE ENTIRE CÔTE-DES-NEIGES—NOTRE-DAME-DE-GRÂCE BOROUGH


PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that :

1. The Côte-des-Neiges—Notre-Dame-de-Grâce Borough Council, at its meeting held on January 15, 2007, adopted the following by-laws :
  - *By-law authorizing a loan of \$2,250,000 to acquire vehicles and associated equipment (RCA07 17119)*, for a term not to exceed 5 years, for purposes of replacing the following vehicles and their equipment: tractor, snowblower head, vacuum litter collector, various trucks, mower and minivans, to provide services for the entire territory of the Côte-des-Neiges—Notre-Dame-de-Grâce borough;
  - *By-law authorizing a loan of \$4,276,000 for work to protect buildings and swimming pools (RCA07 17120)*, for a term not to exceed 20 years, for purposes of carrying out protective and upgrading work at Trenholme centre, the Notre-Dame-de-Grâce Manoir and community centre, various park buildings, and Kent and Benny pools.
2. The two loans shall be a burden on all ratepayers of the Côte-des-Neiges—Notre-Dame-de-Grâce borough.
3. Qualified voters entitled to be entered on the referendum list of the Côte-des-Neiges—Notre-Dame-de-Grâce borough may request that by-laws RCA07 17119 and RCA07 17120 be submitted to a referendum poll by entering their name, address and capacity, together with their signature, in either of the two separate registers open for this purpose for these two by-laws.
4. The number of signatures needed to require that a referendum poll be held is 2406 for each of by-laws RCA07 17119 and RCA07 17120. If this number is not reached, the by-law(s) will be deemed approved by qualified voters.
5. The conditions that must be met to be considered a qualified voter entitled to be entered on the referendum list of the Côte-des-Neiges—Notre-Dame-de-Grâce borough may be obtained from the Borough Office, located at 5160 Décarie, Suite 600, during normal office hours, i.e. from Monday to Friday, 8:30 a.m. to noon and 1 to 4:30 p.m.
6. The register will be open from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m., from Tuesday, January 30 to Friday, February 2, 2007, at the Côte-des-Neiges—Notre-Dame-de-Grâce Accès Montréal office, located at 5160, boulevard Décarie, ground-floor.
7. To sign the register, qualified voters entitled to have their names entered on the referendum list must establish their identity by presenting their health-insurance card, driver's licence or Canadian passport.

8. The results of the registration process will be announced in the room where the registration is held, on Friday, February 2, 2007, at 7 p.m. or as soon as they are available.
