



COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the city council meeting of February 26, 2007:

- 02-135-1 Règlement abrogeant le Règlement sur la subvention relative aux bâtiments résidentiels endommagés par l'oxydation de la pyrite (R.R.V.M. chapitre S-7.1.2), tel que modifié par le règlement 02-135**
[By-law repealing the By-law concerning subsidies for residential buildings damaged by pyrite oxidation (S-7.1.2), as amended by by-law 02-135]
- 07-009 Règlement modifiant le Règlement concernant les taxes spéciales sur les commerces, occupations et activités (R.R.V.M., chapitre T-3)**
[By-law amending the By-law concerning special taxes on businesses, occupations and activities (T-3)]
The object is to increase the fees for a horse-drawn vehicle permit to \$250.
- 05-013-2 Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur les services (05-013, modifié)**
[By-law amending the By-law concerning departments (05-013)]
The object is, in particular, to establish the Service des communications et des relations avec les citoyens, transfer the enforcement of parking by-laws to the Service de police, and transfer the responsibility for government relations to the Service des affaires corporatives.
- 04-047-36 Règlement modifiant le Plan d'urbanisme de la Ville de Montréal (04-047)**

The by-laws come into force on March 5, 2007, and may be consulted during regular office hours at the Direction du greffe, 275, rue Notre-Dame Est.
