The meeting will be preceded by a public consultation meeting, at 6 p.m., concerning the two following proposals:

- draft by-law RCA07 17128 amending the *Urban Planning By-law* of the Côte-des-Neiges—Notre-Dame-de-Grâce borough (01-276), concerning the number of parking spaces required near a metro station, the uses authorized in zones 0788 and 0797, and the boundaries of the use sector for zones 0154 and 0156
- draft resolution CA07 170172 approving specific proposal PP-32, to amend the By-law concerning the construction and occupancy of a six-storey building housing a research institute, at the southwest corner of rue Légaré and avenue Bourret, and concerning the transformation (expansion) and occupancy of the main entrance to the Jewish General Hospital (01-245).
