

COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of January 31, 2008:

RCG 05-002-1 **Règlement modifiant le Règlement du conseil d'agglomération sur la délégation de l'entretien du réseau principal d'aqueduc et d'égout aux municipalités liées (RCG 05-002)**

[By-law of the urban agglomeration council concerning the delegation to related municipalities of the maintenance of waterworks and sewer systems (RCG 05-002)]

The object is to amend the list of structures and pumping stations of the urban agglomeration that are not covered by the delegation to related municipalities.

Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the urban agglomeration council meeting of February 28, 2008:

RCG 08-008 **Règlement modifiant le Règlement sur le régime de rentes des employés de Ville de Saint-Laurent (1279)**

The by-law is amended, for administrative purposes, and to reflect agreement 44 between the Association des pompiers de Montréal Inc. and the city.

RCG 07-025-1 **Règlement modifiant le Règlement concernant le régime complémentaire de retraite des employés de la Ville d'Anjou (1636)**

The by-law is amended due to the use of the actuarial surplus to improve the plan.
