

- Draft resolution CA08 170127 approving specific proposal PP-37, so as to authorize a sign larger than that permitted for a building at 6536, rue Saint-Jacques, under the *By-law on specific construction, alteration or occupancy proposals for an immovable* (RCA02 17017)
- Draft by-law RCA08 17144 amending the *By-law concerning architectural integration plans of the Côte-des-Neiges—Notre-Dame-de-Grâce borough* (RCA07 17121) so as to specify certain development goals and objectives and criteria applicable to the future building occupied for the “short-term accommodation” use and make certain administrative changes to simplify its application.
