THAT said project affects the entire territory of the former Ville de Pierrefonds and Ville de Roxboro.

THAT in the course of this public meeting, the Mayor of the Borough will explain this draft by-law and the consequences of its adoption, and also hear parties who wish to express their concerns.

THAT this draft by-law does not contain provisions relating to a by-law that is susceptible to be approved by referendum.
