

OPENING OF A REGISTER

TO QUALIFIED VOTERS ENTITLED TO HAVE THEIR NAMES ENTERED ON THE REFERENDUM LIST FOR THE ENTIRE CÔTE-DES-NEIGES—NOTREDAME-DE-GRÂCE BOROUGH

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that:

- **1.** The Côte-des-Neiges—Notre-Dame-de-Grâce Borough Council, at its meeting held on June 2, 2008, adopted the following by-law:
 - By-law RCA08 17145 amending By-law authorizing a loan of \$2,250,000 to acquire vehicles and associated equipment (RCA07 17119).

The object of this by-law is to replace Appendix A.

- **2.** The loan shall be a burden on all ratepayers of the Côte-des-Neiges—Notre-Dame-de-Grâce borough.
- Qualified voters entitled to be entered on the referendum list of the Côte-des-Neiges—Notre-Dame-de-Grâce borough may request that by-law RCA08 17145 be submitted to a referendum poll by entering their name, address and capacity, together with their signature, in the register open for this purpose.
- 4. The conditions that must be met to be considered a qualified voter entitled to be entered on the referendum list of the Côte-des-Neiges—Notre-Dame-de-Grâce borough may be obtained from the Borough Office, located at 5160 Décarie, Suite 600, during normal office hours, i.e. from Monday to Friday, 8:30 a.m. to noon and 1 to 4:30 p.m.
- 5. The register will be open from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m., from Monday, June 16, 2008 to Thursday June 19, 2008, at the Côte-des-Neiges—Notre-Dame-de-Grâce Accès Montréal office, located at 5160, boulevard Décarie, ground floor.
- 6. The number of signatures needed to require that a referendum poll be held is 2384. If this number is not reached, the by-law will be deemed approved by qualified voters.
- 7. To sign the register, qualified voters entitled to have their names entered on the referendum list must establish their identity by presenting their health-insurance card, driver's licence or Canadian passport.
- **8.** The results of the registration process will be announced in the room where the registration is held, on Thursday June 19, 2008, at 7 p.m. or as soon as they are available.
- **9.** The by-law may be consulted at the Accès Montréal Office, at 5160, boulevard Décarie, ground floor, from Monday to Friday between 8:30 a.m. and 5 p.m. and on Saturday from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.
