PUBLIC NOTICE

TO QUALIFIED VOTERS ENTITLED TO HAVE THEIR NAMES ENTERED ON THE REFERENDUM LIST OF ROXBORO SECTOR

PUBLIC NOTICE IS GIVEN OF THE FOLLOWING:

1. At a regular sitting held on October 6, 2008, the Council of the Borough of Pierrefonds-Roxboro adopted by-law 93-555-24 modifying zoning by-law 93-555 in order to permit under specific conditions winter car shelters on the territory of the former Ville de Roxboro.
2. Qualified voters being entitled to have their names entered on the referendum list may request that this by-law be submitted to a referendum poll, by entering their name, address, and capacity, and by affixing their signature in the register open for this purpose.
3. The number of signatures required for a referendum poll to be held is **four hundred fifty-six (456)**.
4. If this number is not reached, the by-law will be deemed approved by the qualified voters.
5. This by-law may be consulted at the office of the Secretary of the Borough, Monday to Thursday, from 8 a.m. to noon and from 1 p.m. to 4:45 p.m., on Friday from 8 a.m. to noon and during opening hours for the register.
6. This register shall be open at the Borough Hall, at 13665 de Pierrefonds Boulevard, on **October 23, 2008**, from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m.
7. The result of the register will be announced at the Borough Hall on October 23, 2008, at 7 p.m.

Conditions to be a qualified voter entitled to have his name entered on the referendum list of Roxboro sector:

Is a qualified voter anyone who, on October 6, 2008, has no reason to be disqualified from voting as envisioned in article 524 of the *Act Respecting Elections and Referendums in Municipalities* and meets the following conditions:

- to be of full age, Canadian citizen and nor be under curatorship;
- and**
- to be domiciled in the concerned sector, to wit, the territory of the former Ville de Roxboro, and, **for at least since six months, in Quebec;**
- or**
- to be, **for at least twelve months**, the owner of a property, or the occupant of a business within the meaning of the Act Respecting Municipal Taxation (L.R.Q., c.F-2.1) located in the concerned sector, to wit, the territory of the former Ville de Roxboro.

Additional particular condition applicable to undivided co-owners of a property or co-occupants of a place of business:

To be designated, by means of a power of attorney signed by the majority of them as being the sole co-owner or co-occupant having the right to have his name entered on the referendum list as owner of the property or as the occupant of the place of business. A co-owner or co-occupant may not be designated if he is otherwise qualified as a domiciled person, the sole owner of a property, or the sole occupant of a place of business.

Condition for a moral person to exercise its right to sign a register:

A moral person, who is qualified to vote, shall exercise its rights by designating by resolution, one of its members, administrators, or employees, who, on October 6, 2008, is of full age and Canadian citizen and who is not under curatorship nor have any reason to be disqualified from voting, as envisioned in article 524 of the *Act Respecting Elections and Referendums in Municipalities*.

MANDATORY IDENTIFICATION

A qualified voter must establish his identity by presenting his health-insurance card issued by the Régie de l'assurance-maladie du Québec, his driver's license or probationary license issued in plastic form by the Société de l'assurance automobile du Québec, or his Canadian passport.
