COMING INTO FORCE OF THE FIRE SAFETY COVER PLAN

Notice is given that a fire safety cover plan was adopted at the urban agglomeration

council meeting of December 18, 2008, in accordance with the Fire Safety Act (S-3.4).

The plan to be implemented over 5 years contains the following elements:

- 1) the gradual implementation of prevention programs to reduce human and physical losses
- 2) the improvement of water supply, where required
- 3) the construction of fire stations, one in the east and one in the west; the relocation of the Dorval fire station for greater efficiency; the redistribution and addition of vehicles.

The fire safety cover plan comes into force January 1st, 2009, and may be consulted during regular office hours at the Direction du greffe, 275, rue Notre-Dame Est.
