



## COMING INTO FORCE OF BY-LAWS

**Notice is given that the following by-laws were adopted at the city council meeting of February 23, 2009:**

- 09-006 Règlement modifiant le Règlement concernant les taxes spéciales sur les commerces, occupations et activités (R.R.V.M. chapitre T-3)**  
[By-law amending the By-law concerning special taxes on businesses, occupations and activities (R.B.C.M., chapter T-3)]  
The object is to increase fees for horsedrawn vehicle permits from \$350 to \$450.
- 09-007 Règlement sur les commerces de prêt sur gages ou d'articles d'occasion**  
[By-law concerning pawnshops and establishments dealing in second-hand goods]  
The by-law requires operators to keep a register of all transactions, identify goods received, and post a sign identifying the business. It prohibits the receipt of certain types of goods, contains penal provisions, and confers powers of inspection to peace officers.
- 09-011 Règlement sur la citation à titre de monument historique de la maison Mary-Dorothy-Molson, située au 9095, boulevard Gouin Ouest**  
[By-law concerning the designation of the Maison Mary-Dorothy-Molson, bearing number 9095, boulevard Gouin Ouest, as a historic monument]
- 04-047-76 Règlement modifiant le Plan d'urbanisme de la Ville de Montréal afin d'intégrer le chapitre de l'arrondissement d'Anjou**
- 04-047-77 Règlement modifiant le Plan d'urbanisme de la Ville de Montréal (04-047)**  
[Rivière-des-Prairies–Pointe-aux-Trembles borough – Maurice-Duplessis–Alexis-Carrel sector]
