PUBLIC NOTICE UNDER SECTION 192 OF SCHEDULE C TO THE CHARTER OF VILLE DE MONTRÉAL

First Notice

At the meeting of April 29, 2009, the executive committee approved the following description of immovables that the city intends to acquire under section 192 of schedule C to the charter.

Part of Boulevard Rosemont and two public lanes, southeast of Rue de Bellechasse, between Rue Papineau and Rue Cartier, in Rosemont–La Petite-Patrie borough, made up of lot 3 795 100 in the cadastre of Québec.

Part of Rue Émile-Journault and 15^e Avenue, in Villeray–Saint-Michel–Parc-Extension borough, made up of lots 2 212 715, 2 212 775, 2 212 886 and 2 212 901 in the cadastre of Québec.

Part of Boulevard Rosemont, between 10^e Avenue and 13^e Avenue, in Rosemont–La Petite-Patrie borough, made up of lot 1 591 164 in the cadastre of Québec.

The owners of immovables expropriated under that section may claim an indemnity from the city. If no agreement is reached, the indemnity is set by the Administrative Tribunal of Québec, at the owner's or the city's request, and sections 58 to 68 of the Expropriation Act (R.S.Q., chapter E-24) apply, adapted as required.

This is the first of three notices to be published by the city.
