



AMENDMENTS TO CONTRACTS FOR THE RECYCLING AND MARKETING OF RECYCLABLE MATERIALS

Under resolution CG09 0245, the urban agglomeration council of Montréal, at the meeting of June 18, 2009, approved amendments to 3 contracts awarded on October 25, 2007, to Rebutis Solides Canadiens (RSC) for the recycling and marketing of recyclable materials for 2009 to 2018 (CG07 0390), and to the lease of December 15, 1999 (CO99 02784). The amendments are in accordance with the ministerial order of April 21, 2009, of the minister of municipal affairs, regions and land occupancy, concerning a blanket permission granted to all municipalities and intermunicipal authorities, until March 31, 2010, to amend certain contracts made with recycling centres (2009, G.O.Q. 2, p. 2262).

The amendments make minor adjustments to the rebate formula established in those contracts, in particular as to the reference to a monthly rather than an annual selling price. The amendments also provide for the payment of an additional monthly amount corresponding to 65% of the difference between the threshold imposed in the ministerial order, namely \$92.05/t, and the following amounts, whichever is higher: the overall monthly index, as established by Recyc-Québec, or the average monthly selling price of RSC. They also provide that, at any time, the maximum amount the city might be required to pay will never exceed \$35/t, and will not exceed, in view of rebates received, \$3M, excluding taxes (GST and QST).
