PUBLIC NOTICE

To sole owners of an immovable, sole occupants of a business establishment, undivided co-owners of an immovable, and co-occupants of a business establishment, concerning the general election of November 1, 2009, in Montréal

NOTICE is given to **sole owners of an immovable and sole occupants of a business establishment** who are not already entitled to be entered on the list of electors as domiciled persons, that they must meet the following conditions to be entered on the list of electors of Montréal:

- 1. be 18 or over on November 1, 2009
- on September 1, 2009, be a natural person, a Canadian citizen, and neither be under curatorship nor under any conviction for an offence constituting a corrupt electoral practice
- on September 1, 2009, have been the sole owner of an immovable or the sole occupant of a business establishment on the territory of Montréal for at least 12 months
- have filed with the returning officer, at the address shown below, an application for entry on the list of electors of Montréal, by September 9, 2009, at 4:30 p.m.

NOTICE is also given to undivided coowners of an immovable and co-occupants of a business establishment who are not already entitled to be entered on the list of electors as domiciled persons, as sole owners of an immovable, or as sole occupants of a business establishment, that they must meet the following conditions to be entered on the list of electors of Montréal:

- 1. be 18 or over on November 1, 2009
- on September 1, 2009, be a natural person, a Canadian citizen, and neither be under curatorship nor under any conviction for an offence constituting a corrupt electoral practice
- on September 1, 2009, have been the undivided co-owner of an immovable or the co-occupant of a busi-

ness establishment on the territory of Montréal for at least 12 months

- have been designated under a power of attorney signed by the majority of co-owners or co-occupants who are qualified to vote on September 1, 2009
- 5. have filed a power of attorney with the returning officer, at the address shown below, **by September 9**, 2009, at 4:30 p.m.

An application for entry or a power of attorney filed **after September 9, 2009, at 4:30 p.m., but no later than September 30, 2009, at 8 p.m.**, last day to file an application with the board of revisors, will be considered as an application for correction to the list of electors, and consequently, will be submitted to the board of revisors.

Applications for entry and power of attorney forms are available from the returning officer or on the Internet site. Applications for entry and powers of attorney take effect on receipt and remain valid as long as they are not withdrawn or replaced.

Any person entered as an elector on the list of electors other than as a domiciled person may vote by mail, but must file a written application with the returning officer **by September 30, 2009**. Application forms are available from the returning officer or on the Internet site.
