APPLICATION FOR A MINOR EXEMPTION

390, Croissant Geneva

Notice is hereby given that the Borough Council, at its regular meeting scheduled for 7 p.m. on February 3, 2010, at 5151, chemin de la Côte-Sainte-Catherine, Montréal, will rule on an application for a minor exemption to authorize a building line 0.65 m from the lot line, for a building on the borough boundary, with street number 390, Croissant Geneva.

This minor exemption would make it possible to authorize an extension on the side of the building, but which faces the public thoroughfare, of about 70 m², taking account of the building lines of certain adjacent buildings, and of the greater distance between the lot line and the right of way of the public thoroughfare in comparison with other adjacent buildings, contrary to article 60 of the *Urban planning by-law for part of Mont-Royal Borough* (01-281), which states that the building line to be respected is only that of the adjacent building.
