PUBLIC REVIEW OF THE LIFE SCIENCES AND HEALTH TECHNOLOGY CLUSTER

Clusters are geographic concentrations of interconnected companies and institutions in a particular field. In the Greater Montréal area, the Life Sciences and Health Technology Cluster is a major engine of economic development encompassing some 620 organizations, namely 150 research centers and 80 foreign corporation subsidiaries, amounting to a workforce of 41,000.
