## SUMMARY OF PLANNING PROGRAM AMENDMENTS

Notice is given in accordance with section 110.3 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (R.S.Q., chapter A-19.1).

By-law 04-047-90 entitled "Règlement modifiant le Plan d'urbanisme de la Ville de Montréal (04-047)" was adopted by the city council at its February 1, 2010 meeting, and came into force on February 8, 2010.

The amendments concern the land use designation, the established sectors for construction and transformation, as well as the density of construction of Quartier Angrignon. The amendments pertaining to the density of construction aim to consolidate a densification area around the perimeter of Angrignon metro station and to create a new densification area along the axis of Boulevard Newman and mainly around the intersection of Boulevard Newman and Rue Léger, in LaSalle borough.

By-law 04-047-71 entitled "Règlement modifiant le Plan d'urbanisme de la Ville de Montréal (04-047)" was adopted by the city council at its March 22, 2010 meeting, and came into force on March 30, 2010.

Amendments include a new residential land use designation and add to the complementary document the parameters detailing the Mount Royal protection and development measures with respect to the property located at 1420, boulevard Mont-Royal.
