### WRITTEN PUBLIC CONSULTATION CONCERNING DRAFT BY-LAW NO. 2099-LAS-10 AMENDING BY-LAW NO. 2099

**NOTICE** is hereby given to all persons interested that:

Council has adopted, at its sitting of July 12, 2021, a draft By-law bearing number 2099-LAS-10 amending By-law No. 2099.

This draft By-law aims at

- Repeal the article 3.1.5.2.1.1 Special information required as appropriate, paragraphe d) for a demolition;
- Repeal the article 3.1.9.1.4 Period of validity for the certificate of authorization for a demolition;
- Repeal the article 6.3 DEMOLITION OF A BUILDING;
- Integrate the repealed provisions into the new by-law governing the demolition of buildings.

This draft by-law does not contain specific provisions that make it subject to approval by referendum and affects the full territory of the LaSalle Borough.

Given the current public health emergency and in compliance with the ministerial decrees relating to procedures other than referendums which are part of the decision-making process of a municipal body and which involve the movement or the gathering of citizens, anyone can submit written comments, by email or by mail for a period of 15 days following the publication of this notice.
