



## PUBLIC NOTICE

### *Canadian Navigable Waters Act*

The City of Montréal hereby gives notice that three (3) applications have been made to the Minister of Transport, pursuant to the *Canadian Navigable Waters Act* for approval of the works described herein and its sites and plans.

Pursuant to paragraph 7(2) of the said Act, the City of Montréal has deposited with the Minister of Transport, on the on-line Common Project Search Registry (<http://cps.canada.ca/>) and under registry numbers 4392, 4283 et 3886, or, under the NPP Files Numbers 2009-300040, 2021-305287 and 2021-304824 a description of the following works, its sites and plans:

- Jacques-Bizard Bridge (Existing Bridge modifications – phase 1 )
- Temporary Works (Jetty, Cofferdams, Barriers Tubidity)
- Jacques-Bizard Bridge (New Bridge)

across the des Prairies River between l'Île-Bizard and Montréal Island (45°29'15.5" N, 73°52'04.6" O, lots numbers 1 843 944, 5 114 503, 5 444 142, 5 114 502, 5 114 634 cadastre of Québec and on a non registered lot), Montréal, province of Québec.
